

# **Utility Pole Tag Holders**

There are millions of utility poles across the United States, and each one is marked to identify the companies that have utility lines associated with that pole. The poles themselves each have a unique identifier. A pole tag holder can be used to hold aluminum or polyethylene pole tags with the letters and numbers making up these identification codes which denote geographic location, route or circuit number, utility pole ID number, state, township, serial number and more.

Utility pole tag holders come in a variety of sizes to accommodate various applications. They can be mounted horizontally or vertically and can hold anywhere from one to twelve alphanumeric pole tags.

- · Alumminum, and black co-extruded HD polyethlene plastic holders available
- Can be mounted using integrated holes and nails, or outdooor-specific adhesive
- · Material thickness aluminum: 0.025"
- Material thickness co-extruded HD polyethlene plastic: 0.055"
- Service temperature aluminum: 200°F
- Service temperature co-extruded HD polyethlene plastic: 180°F
